

# CSS Tabs with CSS Navigation Menu

100% CSS, No JavaScript, No jQuery

These Tabs and the Navigation Menu are created using 100% CSS only. Even the transitions present are achieved using CSS only (Rather than JavaScript/jQuery). These tabs behave like general JavaScript Tabs, and the navigation menu gives you the ability to link to specific tabs through hash tags in the URL.

Further, this package comes in 5 different background combinations (Dark Grain, Light Grain, Wood, Brick, Bokeh). Check out the screenshot and video preview to learn more.

## Adding New Tabs

Adding new tabs is really easy, you can add as many tabs as you want, just add another hyperlink within **<nav>** with the anchor link as the hash-tag that matches the **ID** of the Tab.

And then, to add the Tab(Content), add something like:

Within **<ul id="boxes">**, where 'ID' is the ID of the Tab.
